

Coronavirus: How are employers responding? Report 5

Our latest survey shows a snapshot of the position from 23 to 30 June 2020 as employers began to consider re-opening offices and the new flexi furlough scheme was announced.

A quarter of employers have already received requests from employees for permanent changes to working arrangements.

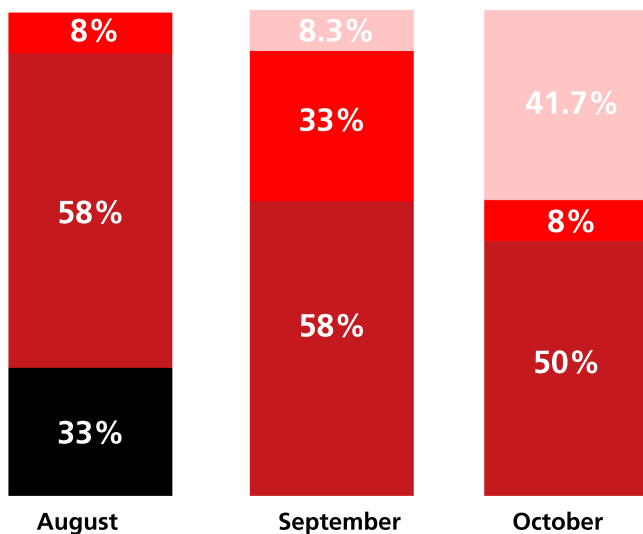

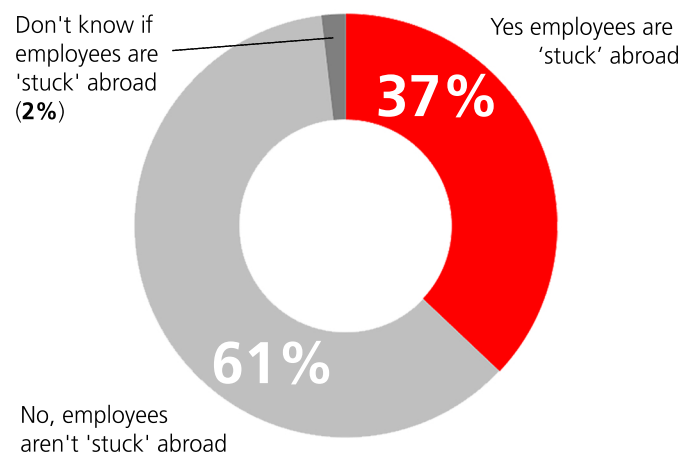
Starting in August, each month employers will have to contribute more to the costs of furlough. As costs rise, employers will bring increasing numbers of employees back into the workforce.



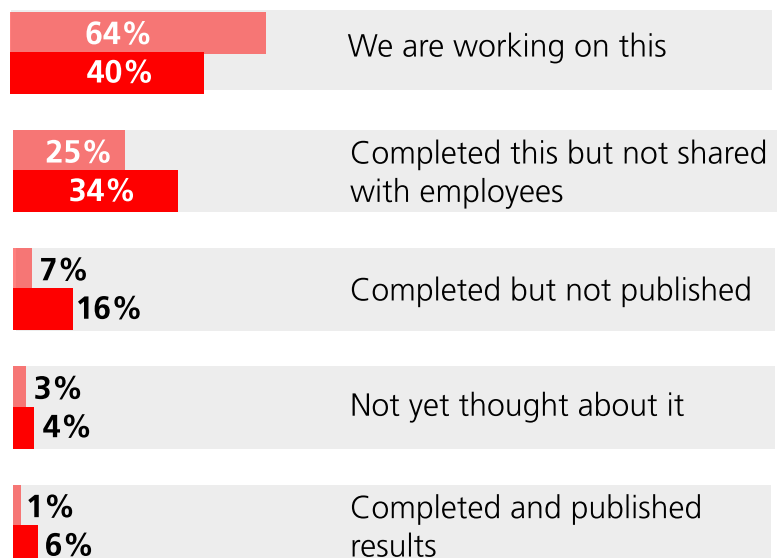
- Will likely END MOST/ALL furlough arrangements (approx 95%)
- Will likely END MANY furlough arrangements (approx 50% - 95%)
- Will likely END SOME furlough arrangements (less than 50%)
- NO CHANGE to furlough arrangements

2 out of 3 might use flexible furlough arrangements

Over a THIRD of employers have employees 'stuck' abroad after travelling to another country before or during lockdown.



56% of employers have now completed risk assessments (up from a third in our previous survey).
