## Coronavirus: How are employers responding? Report 5



Our latest survey shows a snapshot of the position from 23 to 30 June 2020 as employers began to consider re-opening offices and the new flexi furlough scheme was announced.

A quarter of employers have already received requests from employees for permanent changes to working arrangements.






**Starting in August,** each month employers will have to contribute more to the costs of furlough. As costs rise, employers will bring increasing numbers of employees back into the workforce.




- Will likely END MOST/ALL furlough arrangements (approx 95%)
