## **Subject: Freedom of Information Request**

Thank you for your email dated 18 April 2018 in which you made the following request:

It states that, in relation to the gender pay gap regulations, "enforcement action will start when the Commission writes to all employers who have not complied with the law."

"The letters will be sent on 9 April and employers will be given 28 days to comply before an investigation takes place and an unlawful act notice is issued. Failure to comply with the regulations will ultimately lead to an unlimited fine decided by the courts."

Please could you provide information on the number of those letters sent on 9 April. If for any reason theses letters were not sent on 9 April, please provide details of the number of letters that were sent on other days (eg 350 on 10 April, 445 on 11 April, etc).

Please also provide an example of the content of the letter that was sent. I will be happy with an anonymised version."

## Response

The Commission sent out 1456 letters to employers who had not reported their gender pay gap, all posted on 9 April 2018.

Template versions of the letters sent are being disclosed to you alongside this letter. Please note that the templates have been redacted to remove information which engages the S40(2) Personal information exemption. Further information about this exemption and how we have applied it can be found in Annex A.
